At the outset, Prof. A.D. Sahasrabudhe, Chairman, AICTE welcomed all the members to the 62<sup>nd</sup> emergent meeting of the Council. He informed the members about the urgent nature of agenda items being placed in today's meeting, amidst partial lockdown in the country due to COVID-2019 pandemic and the modified calendar of Approval related activities, as being informed to the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Maintaining the norms of physical distancing in this period, majority of the members joined this meeting through Video Conferencing.

The formal Agenda Items were taken up and the following matters were considered, deliberated upon and decisions taken are as under:

**Item No. 62.01.01** : To ratify the decision of the Chairman, AICTE in respect of the  
**Approval Bureau** following:

- i) Grant of LOI/LOA/LOR (as applicable) to institutions based on the recommendations of SAC/EVC in respect of applications received under Chapter-I of APH-20202-21 for setting up of new technical institutions offering a Technical Programme at Diploma/ Post Diploma Certificate/ Under Graduate Degree/ Post Graduate Diploma/ Post Graduate Degree Level in the AY 2020-21;
- ii) Grant of Extension of Approval (EOA) for the AY 2020-21 to the existing technical institutions whose cases were under process in all the categories covered under Chapter-II of APH-20202-21, since the last Council meeting held.

**The Council was informed that entire Approval Process 2020-21 has been done online due to COVID-2019 pandemic with online Scrutiny, EVC etc. Hon'ble Supreme Court this year agreed to the request of AICTE to change the Calendar for completion of the Approval Process from April 30, 2020 to June 15, 2020. However, since all the applications for new institutes were not possible to be completed before 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020, an additional M.A. with DY No. 13423/2020 in CA No. 9048/2012 is filed for requesting to extend the date till June 30, 2020. The Council in its 61<sup>st</sup> Emergent meeting authorized Chairman, AICTE to take an appropriate decision in the remaining applications/cases of Chapter-I and Chapter-II, which were under process, as per APH 2020-21.**



The Council ratified the following decisions of Chairman, AICTE:

- i) Grant of LOI/LOA/LOR (as applicable) to 296 institutions based on the recommendations of SAC/EVC in respect of applications received under Chapter-I of APH-2020-21 for setting up of new technical institutions offering a Technical Programme at Diploma/ Post Diploma Certificate/ Under Graduate Degree/ Post Graduate Diploma/ Post Graduate Degree Level in the AY 2020-21;
- ii) Two applications for setting up of new institutions are under process;
- iii) Grant of Extension of Approval (EOA) for the AY 2020-21 to three (03) existing technical institutions whose cases were under process in all the categories covered under Chapter-II of APH-2020-21, since the last Council meeting held.

A revised Calendar, as annexed, was placed during deliberations and the same was approved by the Council.

The Council was also informed that Standing Appeal Committee (SAC) meetings are being held till 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020 to process the remaining cases for AY 2020-21. The Council, as per practice empowered Chairman, AICTE to take decision on all remaining cases and same may be placed in the next meeting of Council for its ratification.

Item No. 62.02.01  
MIC

: To consider and approve the proposed budget for organizing Drug Discovery Hackathon 2020.

The Council was informed that the current pandemic situation of COVID-2019 has led to a suggestion to hold 'Drug Discovery Hackathon 2020' which shall address COVID-2019 and beyond. The Principal Scientific Adviser to GOI vide letter dated June 24, 2020 has informed that with the support of MIC-AICTE and CSIR, a hackathon has been conceptualized to establish training and leadership in the area of computational approaches to drug discovery in our country. The proposed Drug Discovery Hackathon 2020 will have 3 phases and the total required budget has been proposed to the tune of Rs. 21.80 Crore. PSA has requested AICTE to make initial provision of Rs.1.5 Cr to partially cover phase-1 expenses of the proposed Hackathon.

The Council appreciated this noble initiative during the COVID-2019 situation and approved the proposed budget of Rs.1.5 Crores from IRG of AICTE, for organizing Drug Discovery Hackathon (DDH) 2020.

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The members were informed that Dr. Usha Natesan, Adviser-I (Approval Bureau) is completing her deputation term in AICTE and shall be joining back to her parent department i.e. Anna University, Chennai. The members of the Council placed on record their appreciation for Dr. Usha Natesan, Adviser (Approval Bureau) for her diligent and noteworthy contribution in AICTE in Approval related matters and preparation of APH in last four years. The Council also extended thanks to the Vice Chancellor, Anna University for agreeing to further extension of her deputation beyond three years in AICTE.

The Council was also informed about the sad demise of Ms. Shavanthi K. Wartika, a regular employee in the Western Regional Office(WRO) - AICTE, Mumbai. All members expressed their condolence and took a minute silence as a mark of respect for the departed soul.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
