Item No. 64.03.01 : To consider and approve the grant of LoA/LoR (as applicable) to the **Approval Bureau** Institutions based on the recommendations of the respective SAC/ EVC and approved by the Competent Authority in respect of applications received under Chapter I, for Setting up of New Technical Institution offering a Technical Programme at Diploma/ Post Diploma Certificate/ Under Graduate Degree/ Post Graduate Diploma/ Post Graduate Degree Level in the AY 2022-23.

The Council was informed that the applications of the New Institutions applied under Chapter-I of the Approval Process Handbook (APH 2022-23) were processed by conducting online Scrutiny/Re Scrutiny/EVC, as applicable. The Council noted that 170 applications for new institutions were received. The Council approved issuance of LOA to 139 institutions and LoR




to 30 institutions. One institution's case is under process.

The Council authorized Chairman, AICTE to take decision for the pending cases and the same may be ratified by the Council in its next meeting.

Dr. R. B. Kakade, Adviser-I, Approval Bureau made a presentation in this regard. Dr. Kakade and his team was congratulated for completion of the process in the stipulated time as per Hon'ble Supreme Court's directions.

The Council was informed about the 8974 total proposals received under Chapter-II of APH for the grant of Extension of Approval (EoA) for the A.Y. 2022-23 to existing technical institutions. The Council considered and approved a total of 8816 institutions for grant of Extension of Approval for the FY 2022-23. 158 cases are still under process for EoA.


