**Subject:- Information on availability of Unisex Toilets for Divyangjan and  
Inventory of Buildings.**

Sir/Madam,

Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD) launched Accessible India Campaign (Sugamya Bharat Abhiyan) as a nation-wide Campaign for achieving universal accessibility for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) on December 3, 2015.

An accessible physical environment benefits everyone, not just persons with disabilities. Measures should be undertaken to eliminate obstacles and barriers to indoor and outdoor facilities, medical facilities in the Institutions. Further, these include all public spaces such as roads, footpaths, parks and gardens etc.

Standards of accessibility should be as consistent as possible with international standards, such as those of the ISO, taking into account the local context. With regards to the built environment, ISO 21542:2011, Building Construction-Accessibility and Usability of the Built Environment, delineates a set of requirements and recommendations concerning construction, assembly, components and fittings. On E-Samiksha Portal (Accessible India Campaign), information about construction of adequate unisex toilets for Divyangjan in each toilet block and inventory of building to be prepared with timelines for making them accessible is to be furnished.

Therefore, you are requested to provide information regarding availability of unisex toilets in your institutions and details on inventory etc. in form <https://forms.gle/c5oRRbCYyiShJQxs5> on or before 15th April, 2023.
