Dear Vice Chancellor,

The National Education Policy 2020 is a comprehensive framework to guide the Education in the country. The policy is mindful that education in future will involve greater digitalization and thus envisages the creation of digital infrastructure, digital content and capacity building to supervise the e-education needs of both school and higher education.

2. **MoE has entrusted the National Testing Agency to conduct online testing and assessment throughout India for admission into select HEIs.** The National Testing Agency to piloting new ways of assessment using emerging education technologies focusing on 21st century skills. Presently, NTA conducts entrance, recruitment and eligibility examinations for various State & Central Government departments, colleges, etc. on pan India basis.

3. PROCESS

In order to conduct its assessments in free, fair and secure manner, the NTA envisions to set up examination centres for Online/ Computer Based Test (CBT) examination in approximately 600+ districts across the country for approx. 2,00,000 candidates per shift. Each of these exam centres will have a minimum of approx. 250 seats.

In order to help NTA set up such a network of examination centres, willing Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are requested to assess the availability of closed space area (Minimum being 6500 Sq. Ft.) in their premises as per the enclosed proforma. This space would be used for provision of new IT infrastructure by the NTA to conduct the exams by NTA.

The NTA will come up with a revenue sharing model for interested Institutions who agree to give exclusive empty space/ area for long duration for the above purpose. The institutions need not pay anything except making available a dedicated closed space.

4. BENEFITS

- i. All HEIs can also utilize these infrastructure to offer targeted training in low-expertise tasks for supporting the AI value chain such as data annotation, image classification, speech transcription and many others.
 - ii. This initiative will assist NTA in achieving the goal of conducting examination across India in a standardized environment and without any scope of malpractice.
 - iii. These exam centres can be utilized by the HEIs to conduct various other ICT based vocational education courses/programmes listed under NEP 2020.
 - iv. This will promote and create future-ready IT enabled standardized Online Examination centres.
 - v. Creation of virtual labs can also be considered in these places which will give students in remote areas to hands-on experiential learning.
