Document Verification: Get the Submitted form verified at the Facilitation cum Document Verification Center.

Filling of Entrance Details: Candidate is requested to fill the details of her/his Entrance Examination from their login using login credentials.

ANNEXURE – I

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO IIST UG PROGRAMME

Candidates desirous of admission to IIST must satisfy **ALL** eligibility criteria detailed below.

- (1) **Citizenship:** Only Indian citizens are eligible to apply for admission in IIST.
- (2) **Date of Birth:** Candidates belonging to General, EWS and OBC-NCL categories must have been born **on or after October 1, 1996**. Candidates belonging to SC/ ST and PD categories must have born **on or after October 1, 1991**.

The date of birth as recorded in the certificate of high school/ first Board/ or its equivalent will be accepted. If the certificate does not mention the date of birth, candidate must, at the time of accepting the seat, submit an authenticated document from a competent authority indicating the same.

- (3) **Minimum Marks Requirement in Qualifying Examination:** Keeping in mind the pandemic situation prevailing in the country, IIST UG Admission 2021 has relaxed this criterion. In line with the decision taken by the Central Seat Allocation Board and the IITs, candidates are now required to only qualify in one of the examinations listed below. **This modification is done for the year 2021 only.**

List of Qualifying Examinations:

Any one of the following will be accepted as the Qualifying Examination:

- The final examination of the 10+2 system, conducted by any recognized central/ State Board, such as

Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi; Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi; etc.

- Intermediate or two-year Pre-University examination conducted by a recognized Board/ University.
- Final examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defense Academy.
- Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling with a minimum of five subjects.
- Any Public School/ Board/ University examination in India or in any foreign country recognized as equivalent to the 10+2 system by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
- H.S.C. vocational examination.
- General Certificate Education (GCE) examination (London/ Cambridge/ Sri Lanka) at the Advanced (A) level.
- High School Certificate Examination of the Cambridge University or International Baccalaureate Diploma of the International Baccalaureate Office, Geneva.

In case the relevant Qualifying Examination is not a public examination, the candidate must have passed at least one public (Board or Pre-University) examination at an earlier level.

(4) Minimum Marks Requirement in JEE (Advanced)–2021 Examination:

Candidates should have appeared for the **Joint Entrance Examination (Main)-2021** conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA), to qualify themselves to appear for the **Joint Entrance Examination (Advanced)- 2020** conducted by IITs and secure the minimum prescribed marks as given below:

Table: Minimum Marks Requirement in JEE (Advanced)–2021 Examination

Sl No.	Category	Minimum Marks
1.	General	At least 16% marks in aggregate and at least 4% marks in each of the three subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics)
2.	EWS/ OBC-NCL	At least 14.4% marks in aggregate and at least 3.6% marks in each of the three subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics)
3.	SC/ ST/ PD	At least 8% marks in aggregate and at least 2% marks in each of the three subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics)
