Sub.: Creation of 2 seats under supernumerary quota for students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. degree course – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter dated 08.03.2017 on the above subject. In this regard, it is informed that the Council of Architecture, based on letter No. D.O. No.F.1-1/2012(SA-III) dated 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 from the Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi, had decided to allow all institutions imparting 5-year B.Arch. degree course in the country to create two (2) seats under supernumerary quota for students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. degree course from 2015-2016 onwards. These supernumerary seats shall be available for institutions imparting 5-year B.Arch. course for the academic session 2017-2018 also.

These seats are to be filled up only by students belonging to Jammu & Kashmir, possessing valid domicile from the state. In the event of non-availability of students from Jammu & Kashmir, these seats must remain vacant. Further, all students admitted under this quota must fulfill the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Council for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year of 5-year B.Arch. degree course and also must have passed an Aptitude Test in Architecture prior to admission.
