CORRIGENDUM - I

With reference to the MHRD Revised Scheme Guidelines of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana by Technical Institutions (PMKVY-TI) for the AY 2018-19, the following Amendments/ Additions have been made to the guidelines:

ADDITIONS

Insert the following at Para 6.4

Mandatory Biometric Attendance Linked to Aadhar: Capturing biometric attendance for students & faculty is mandatory and shall subsequently be linked to Aadhar. All institutes must cater to the following:-


- (a) The biometric devices for capturing student attendance are hereby mandatory and minimum 70% attendance be ensured for assessment by all institutes running the programme for AY 2018-19.
- (b) Attendance of students must be uploaded at the end of 30-day cycle by the training provider on the AICTE portal.
- (c) Simultaneous trial run for linking of the biometric system with the Aadhar will be conducted by every institution. The institutions will undertake trials to integrate their system with AICTE portal and address any issues. Post stabilization, the fund release would be linked to Aadhar based biometric attendance system.
- (d) The detailed instructions and modalities for the institutes regarding the same will be issued separately and uploaded on AICTE website.

Insert the following at Para 6.5

Timeline for each approved course under the scheme: The National Steering Committee has mandated the following timelines for completion of course: -

- (a) Course/ QP of 250-400 notional hours is to be completed in maximum of six (06) months.
- (b) Course/ QP of 400-600 notional hours is to be completed in maximum of Nine (09) months.
