Aspirants of PMSSS scholarship under Medical Stream.

All aspirants of PMSSS scholarship under Medical stream are hereby directed to comply with the following and other information in this regard are as mentioned under:

1. All NEET qualified Medical aspirants should attend counselling of the State where the student intends to take admission on his / her own in an approved Medical / Dental college.
2. Every student should have a valid NEET score card and counselling / allotment letter of current academic session 2020-21.
3. After taking admission in a Medical / Dental college, the student should upload the joining report, NEET score card and allotment letter issued by the State Counselling Board on the PMSSS, AICTE Portal.
4. All the aspirants should note that the PMSSS Scholarship under Medical stream is limited and it is only 100 in number.
5. In case number of applicants are more than 100 only top 100 students as per merit list of PMSSS (already published) will be considered.
6. Reservation policy as per State Quota will be applied.
7. Holding of NEET score card and admission in a Medical / Dental college will not guarantee a candidate scholarship under PMSSS.
8. The aspirants should upload the above mandatory documents within the last date of admission in a medical/college as decided by MCI/DCI.
9. AICTE will publish the final list of the 100 eligible candidates on its portal.
