2nd Conference of Academic Leadership on National Education Policy

All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi in association with Bharatiya Shikshan Mandal (BSM), UGC, IGNOU, AIU, IGNCA, JNU, ICSSR, RNT and STPI is organizing the 2nd ‘Conference of Academic Leadership on the National Education Policy’ at AICTE, New Delhi on Saturday, 27th July 2019. The objective of the conference is to discuss, debate and deliberate on the Draft National Education Policy for evolving a roadmap of transforming higher education through interaction, collaboration and consensus. The participants of the conference will be top academic leadership of the country comprising of seasoned academicians and educationists, vice-chancellors of Central, State & Private Universities, Directors of Institutions of national importance and prominent research organizations. About 400 participants are expected to attend the conference. Last year, the 1st Conference of Academic Leadership on ‘Education for Resurgence’ was held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi on 29th September, 2018 which was inaugurated by the Hon’ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi. More than 400 eminent educationists actively participated in the conference.

Hon’ble Minister for Human Resource Development, Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal ‘Nishank’ has kindly given his consent for the inauguration of the conference to be held on 27th July, 2019 at the AICTE auditorium, ‘Prajnan Bhavan’ and has agreed for participation throughout the event. The heads of higher education regulatory and funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, AICTE etc. are expected to participate in the day-long intellectual discourse. The top academic leaders will participate in the Manthan-Group discussion on action

points for which eight tracks have been identified, namely Classification, Massification & Global Outreach; Funding of Research - Strengthening the Future; Autonomy in Governance – Re-Structuring the Regulators; Specialization & De-compartmentalization, Our Language – Our Thought; Generation of Funds – Regeneration of Goodwill; Esteem of Educators; Dignity of Qualifications; and Flexibility in Curriculum – Creativity in Education.
