1. DEFINITIONS

2. Registration of user and ACCESSING OF BID DOCUMENTS:

- i. It is mandatory for all the Applicants to have digital signature certificate (in the name of person who will sign the Application Form) from any of the licensed certifying agency(“CA”) *Applicants can see the list of licensed CAs from the link www.cca.gov.in to participate in e- auctioning Process.

1.1 DEFINITIONS

AUCTIONEER – M/s ITI Limited (e-Wizard System), an agency appointed as an Service provider/auctioneer to facilitate auction on e-auction/ Internet on behalf of the Custodian (AICTE) on their website <https://mhrd.euniwizarde.com/> They are expected to facilitate organizing and conducting an auction and are considered as third party not particularly interested in the item being sold for and on behalf of the All India Council for Technical Education

BIDDER – Any person representing as an individual OR as proprietor OR as a partner OR as an authorized representative of any company and who is Registering himself on the website <https://mhrd.euniwizarde.com/> and paying the stipulated amount of Earnest Money/Caution Money to decide/ set their bidding Limits is considered as a Registered Bidder. One individual can represent as a bidder on his own behalf and on behalf of other persons/companies provided he registers himself in those capacities separately. i.e. for each representation he should pay separate stipulated caution money and set the Bidding Limits. But he can't register separately for himself & company at the same time.

1.2. PARTICIPATION

- (i) Only REGISTERED Bidders shall be allowed to participate in the on-line auctions. To become REGISTERED Bidder one needs to register with the auctioneer website <https://mhrd.euniwizarde.com/> either on-line or in person at office of auctioneer.
- (ii) Registered Bidders will be required to E-mail/Fax/Courier/Hand Delivered a duly signed copy of the Form “**Acceptance to Participate Form**” given in Annexure –II to the office of the Auctioneer thereby giving their consent to terms and conditions of the Online Auction Sale. The Auctioneer will activate Identity and Passwords of the Registered Bidders in the Online Auction method of Bidding ONLY after receipt of the signed Registration Form and On Payment of prescribed CMD.
- (iii) Bidder shall **enter a valid e-mail ID** in the Registration Form. All e-mail communications will be forwarded to the e-mail ID entered in the Registration Form.
- (iv) **Time Extension:** If any market-leading bid (bid higher than the highest at the point in time) is received within the last 10 minutes (“Time Extension” as mentioned in the Bidding Room will be in force & 10 Minutes is an example) of closing time, the time will be extended automatically by 10 minutes

[v] Auto Bid:

- a. Auto Bid facility is provided for bidders intending to place a maximum value for a Items.
 - b. Auto bid is not a confirmed bid. It is only the maximum ceiling amount set by the bidder to enable the auction engine to place bids on his behalf, whenever he is out bided, up to the ceiling set by him.
 - c. Once auto bid is set, the auction engine will consider the ceiling amount for the next possible Bid only, depending on the highest bid prevailing at that point of time and the increment amount prescribed for items.

- a. Bidder shall bid for the whole as “Signal lot”. Acceptance/rejection of highest bid will also be for the whole as one lot. During the process, all items will be treated as one lot.
 - b. The rates will be exclusive of any Tax i.e. basic rates.
 - c. The process will be as Standard auction. The bidder shall be able to see their own bid and highest bid only, without any information/identity of other bidders.
1. The highest bid for whole lot shall be subject to the confirmation hereinafter mentioned as STC. In the event of any dispute as to last or highest bid, the same shall be decided by the AICTE representative present at the sale.
 2. The goods will be sold as Signal lot basis and the delivery will also be given as one lot only. Goods may be sold in one lot only as found suitable and convenient and / or advantageous in the opinion of the AICTE representative present at the Auction Sale.
 3. The auction may be withdrawn from sale at any time before it is actually sold / delivered without assigning any reason for such withdrawal.
 4. The Auctioneers may, in consultation with the AICTE representative present at the sale, refuse to accept the bid of any person or persons without giving any reason whatsoever.
 5. All bids invited are for the net amount accruable to The All India Council for Technical Education and all taxes or other levies charged, GST or local taxes/laws as applicable on the date of delivery except Customs Duty shall be payable by the bidder. **These taxes are required to be paid before taking delivery by the bidder/tenderer in Govt. account by them self.**

- ii) In respect of e-auction, on acceptance of Rate / Offer on subject to confirmation basis (STC), the bidder will have to pay 20% of purchase price as CMD with AICTE within 3 (Three) working days from the date of intimation, failing which the CMD shall be forfeited. However, for delay due to genuine reasons, further extension would be with the condition of levy of 0.25% of bid value for first seven days, 0.50% of bid value for second seven days and 1% of bid value for 3rd segment of seven days. Member Secretary will decide the genuineness of reasons for delay and quantum of days to be allowed. The amount of Caution Money Deposit paid by the bidder can be adjusted against the EMD payable.
- iii) The confirmation for delivery of goods shall be intimated after getting the approved Bill of Entry in the name of the successful bidders. The bidders shall have option to collect the approved/Processed Bill of Entry from AICTE, arrange payment of the same to AICTE along with payment of Balance Bid amount and VAT as applicable and take delivery of the auctioned goods / goods within five (5) days from the date following the date of approval of Bill of Entry. However, for delay due to genuine reasons, further extension would be with the condition of levy of 0.25% of bid value for first seven days, 0.50% of bid value for second seven days and 1% of bid value for 3rd segment of seven days. The decision of the AICTE will be final and binding on the bidders to decide genuineness of reasons for delay and quantum of days to be allowed. - v] If the purchaser fails to take the delivery of the goods within the maximum period permitted by AICTE on payment of rental warehousing charges as detailed above, the earnest money deposited by them will be automatically forfeited and the Goods will be re-listed for the sale without any further notice.
- vi) The payment will be accepted on all working days from 10.00 hrs. to 16.00 hrs. only. The Delivery of the goods will be given on Working days during 10:00 hrs. to 17:00 hrs. only or as decided by the AICTE.
6. The purchaser of items shall give his name, address, fax number, e-mail, phone / mobile number to the auctioneers. If the purchaser fails to pay the earnest money after the items are allotted him, the bid shall forthwith be cancelled and the lot re- auctioned on account and at the risk of defaulting purchaser who shall be responsible for the deficit, if any, in the price but shall not be entitled to any increase, if any arising from such resale, AICTE shall reserves the right to take such action against the defaulting bidder as may be authorized by the law.
7. No sale shall be invalidated by reason of any defect or faults in bidding process and no compensation shall be paid in respect of any such faults or errors of description.
8. The goods are sold “AS & WHERE THEY LIE” condition. No selection or sorting of the

material will be allowed. Quality, quantity, size, measurement, number and weight stated are approximate. Goods are sold on the assumption that the bidders have inspected the prior to the bidding and know what they are bidding for. No complaint shall be entertained after the highest bid accepted.

9. The goods shall lie at the sole risk and responsibility of the Purchaser in all respects from the time of sale and must be taken away by the Purchaser at his own expenses within stipulated time.
10. If the goods are not removed within the specified period, the EMD/CMD and the other payment made by the Purchaser will be forfeited. Similarly, in case, AICTE Administration could not deliver the goods within the specified time due to unanticipated administrative reasons, suitable extension of period shall be granted to the purchaser and he will not be liable to pay ground rent or any other charges, till the expiry of such extended period of date of intimation whichever is earlier.
11. When AICTE's unserviceable items/scrap goods are sold on basis of one lot and the purchaser fails to obtain the delivery of the whole, he shall not be entitled to make any claim other than for the proportionate refund of the value of the undelivered quantity. He shall not be entitled to claim any damage, loss or profit, interest on compensation or any other account, access quantity, if any, will be paid for in advance before the material is removed.
12. All bidders/ purchasers shall be deemed to have read and acquainted themselves with these conditions of sale and agree to give their bids subject to these conditions. The bidder shall be deemed to have self-satisfied regarding eligibility. No claim from any bidders regarding their eligibility shall be entertained at any later stage. In case of physical auction, in the event of any dispute regarding amount of highest bid, the decision of the auction committee present at sale will be final and binding to the bidders. 15. If the goods other than mentioned are found at the time of delivery, the sale may be cancelled by the AICTE administration. In such case the refund of CMD or any other payments made by the purchaser shall be given by the AICTE without any interest unless it is forfeited as above.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

16. In respect of offers acceptable to AICTE on "Subject to Confirmation" the decision will be announced within 45 days or any extended time thereafter by AICTE which will be binding to the bidder. The Confirmation of Sale will be issued after getting approved from Member Secretary.

17. Any information regarding acceptance under STC, other information such as notices, extension of time etc. will be communicated to the respective bidders through Post/E-Mail / Fax. Bidder also should be in touch with the auctioneer to have exact information will not be entertained by this office.
18. Balance amount to be paid to AICTE should be either by account payee Pay Order or Demand Draft drawn in favor of Member Secretary, AICTE, payable at New Delhi or through RTGs in designated account of AICTE, before start of delivery.
